THE CHALLENGES FACES TO MR JOSEPH WITH HIS FAMILY.

- He does not have specific job instead of working to other people's farm to earn money. The economic situation of Joseph is not good so he is not able to provide basic need to his family especially to his children who study.
- He does not have a good house. He has mud house. In rain season the house can be destroyed due to water draining, appearance of house not good for human consumption.
- He lives in bush area. So, if it happens the problems in night no help will be given from somebody as neighbors because you cannot find any houses around that area.
- The children walk more than 10 kilometers to go to school, they are always late at school and they arrive at school when they are already tired. This problem leads them to have poor performance at school even though they really like to study.
- Lack of food to feed his family. Joseph does not have a specific job to earn money so sometimes his family sleep without eating, he asked support for house building and food if possible because suddenly his family is big and all of them depend on him.

CHALLENGES FACES TO MR SELEMANI WITH HIS FAMILY.

- He has a poor life and having big family of 6 children and 3 grandchildren. He asks support to get house because he lives one house with his family. They live in mad house and the house is not big enough to be used to all of them.
- He asks food support, he cannot feed the family due to a size of family is too bigger, all of them depend on him. He has the daughters were married but recently, they come back home after break up with their husband, so they depend on **Mr Sulemani** in case of anything like basic needs.
- He needs support to his children like school equipment, he works in farm to get food to feed the family also some portion is taken to sell to earn money. He sells some crops to get money to help the children but the problem now days no big enough rain leads them to cultivate gets food and money after sell the crop to help children.
- The children walk more than 10 kilometers to go to school, they are always late at school and they arrive at school when they are already tired. This problem leads them to have poor performance at school even though they real like to study.
- He needs water support, water is not available at place, they walk a lot of kilometers of find it and always gets dirty water. They ask support to get even pump well if possible.

CHALLENGES FACES TO VANDUSA RASHID WITH HIS FAMILY.

- She is a mother of 7 children, she is famer but now days the weather is change not a big enough rainfall so agriculture is not helpful to get food to feed the family. she is widow and she is also responsible to take care the family herself.
- She needs support house support, because her house is broken and it was made with mad now, she lives in her elder sisters’ house until she gets her house.
- She needs food support, she has a big family no one work except herself, this is a big challenge because all children depend on her. She has children who were married but still needs support from her because they live in poor life and their husbands are jobless.
- She needs support to her children who are students, she supposed to provide all school needs to her children if it is needed, the life she lives cannot be able to support her children especially school needs so many times she faces some debts to ask money to help her children and finally she does not able to pay back.
- She needs water support, they live in bush no water, they walk more 3 or 5 kilometers to get clean water.
- She needs support to her children, they work 6 kilometers a day to go school, they might face some dangerous animals on the way.

I conclude that these people live a poor life, I suggest to support them either to build house or provide them food, because the leaders of these families do not have permanent jobs or good jobs except to work to other people's farm as day workers and earn a little money which cannot support them to get all basic needs like food, clothes and to support the children.

We as a **SHARE LIGHT COMPANY**, we can think in which area that we can give support but this is fact these people need support, they don't have hope in life according to the nature of their life. I got enough time to talk with them, among of their complains was about support of house and food.

Generally, these people accept to respond any kind of helps due to the challenge faces their life. I finally took pictures and changed contacts to keep in touch.
